Principal Greco Updates:

SCA (Short Cycle Assessment) Data – this is an assessment or STAAR-like test of the 9 weeks of learning that the District expects students to have mastered in those 9 weeks. It is every 9 weeks, total of 4 assessments per school year. This will build students stamina to online testing. In 2023 STAAR will be moving to online testing. For this year, it will be a choice for students.

Reading, Math, Science for 3rd, 4th, 5th grades. Out of 78 schools we averaged 18th place for “Meets” in Math. We averaged 17th for “Meets” in Reading (ELA – English Language Arts). In Science we were

16th out of 78 schools for “Meets”. We’re hoping to make it to the top 10 schools for SCA2 (Short Cycle Assessment 2nd period).

As a school our goal is to achieve the below % for each grade level that participates in SCA:

90% Approaches | 60% Meets | 30% Masters

- If we can meet these goals, we will move from a C school to an A school. We hit above 30% level in all areas for Masters across all grade levels!

Showed SCA scores by grade level. Seeing a problem across the district in Reading in 3rd grade. We are still above the district average but need to get our 3rd grade readers caught up. There are conversations happening at the District level about how to help 3rd graders get up to level for all schools. It was due to being out of school for so long due to covid.

Virtual Student Updates

Sent a communication to virtual families to save dates for campus tours. The tours are during the day so families can see what the day will be like when their students return in Jan 2022. Tours will be on Dec 3rd at 9am and Dec 7th at 2pm.

There will be a Spring Welcome Back to School night on Dec 9th from 4-5pm. This will be an opportunity to meet teachers, tour classrooms, go over pick up/drop off procedures, security questions and any other concerns.

Still waiting to hear from the District on staffing and teachers to accommodate for the return of virtual students. Trying to work with the District to ensure that we are staffed and prepared for students of all abilities and grade levels. Due to losing 2 staff members in September because of leveling, our classes are very full.

Winter Parties

There will be Winter Parties on Dec 16th for students, but parents cannot join due to the District's guidelines on non-staff members in the buildings. Will get more information from your teachers closer to the date about their parties.
