#### Citizens Communications


- School AC: gym and cafeteria AC was replaced over the summer; hot weeks a few weeks

      - State requires 3<sup>rd</sup> grade reading and math goal; Ms. Greco took results last year and data informed where we focus;
      - Desired Annual Outcome 1: Goal 2 Students identified as economically disadvantaged demonstrating achievement on 3rd grade state assessment in reading at the Meets Grade Level will increase from 41% to 60% by August 2024.
