

#### Dance Choreography


#### Create an original dance

- Create choreography to match the theme.
- The choreographer may choose to perform or have someone else perform.
- Pay close attention to the accepted file types for Dance Choreography video footage.

#### Film Production

#### Create a short live or digital movie

- Pay close attention to the accepted file types for Film Production.
- Official rules for Film Production can be accessed here.



#### Literature

#### Write a poem, story, letter, tale or essay

- Entries must not be over 2,000 words.
- Official rules for Literature can be accessed here.



#### Music Composition

#### Write an original song and record it

- Pay close attention to the accepted file types for Music Composition.
- Videos are not an acceptable format. All entries must be audio only.

#### Photography

#### Take a picture or several pictures to create a collage

- Print dimensions must be between 3" X 5" and 8" X 10".
- Multi-print entries and collections are not accepted. Photomontages must be combined digitally and printed on a single page.

#### Visual Arts

#### You can draw, paint, or create a picture

- Make sure your Visual Arts entry is not 3D! This includes "googly eyes" or anything else that takes the Visual Arts entry into anything that would not sit absolutely flat in transport.
- All entries must be less than 24" X 30" and paper entries should be mounted.

#### Accessible Arts Division

- Students who identify as having a disability have two ways to enter:
  - 1. Enter in Grade-Level Division: regardless of age, students with disabilities may enter in the grade division most closely aligned to their support needs.
  - 2. Enter in Accessible Arts Division: Eligible students entering the division create their own artwork but may receive non-artistic accommodation and assistance from an adult.

## The Artist's Statement An important step!

- Make sure you write a descriptive and meaningful Artist Statement on your entry form so you can tell the judges how your art reflects this year's theme of: Accepting Imperfection.
- Many times, the artist statement will make a huge difference during judging because this is where you as the artist can explain in your own words, your thoughts and feelings for the piece.



#### Enter Multiple Times

#### Go for it!

- You may enter more than once in as many categories and as many times as you choose using the theme of: Accepting Imperfection.
- Make sure each entry has a separate Entry Form.
